It creates a fascination, which is intensified by the observation and comparison with the irides of other human beings.</p> <p>Surprisingly, the shape of the iris looks very similar to the Earth, with its irregular lines, its valleys, hills, peaks and its bright varied shade and colours (see appendix). Our eye itself up close and far away is a whole world. And according to our own way of keeping an eye on the planet today, we act on its sustainable future.</p>

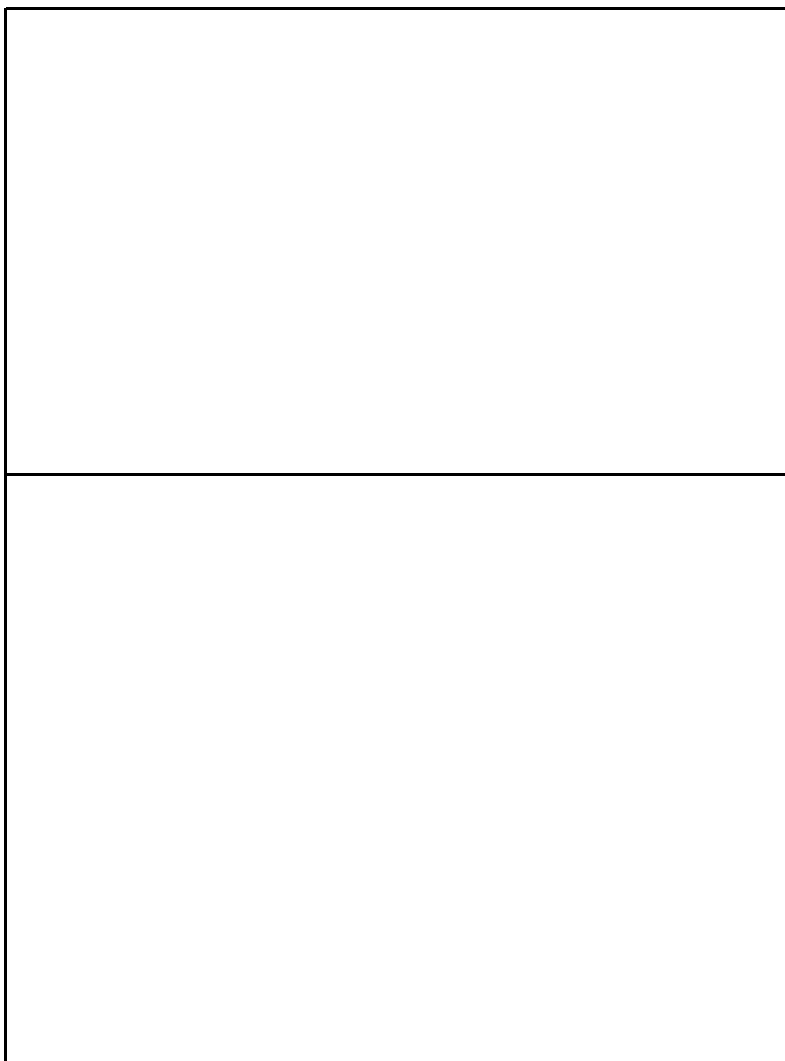
